- When he speaks for something he becomes a witness.
- Now his occasion has come to speak for democracy one of the travail and agony of his soul.

② John I A Great New Testament Word

- The woman at the well hurrying back to her village and friends.
- Peter at Pentecost - "We are witnesses of these things."
- Philip and the Eunuch

John is the center of our life - John on the Isle of Patmos.

③ We need to recover the power and spontaneity of that word.

But we have no deep convictions One of which we

① Because the Loyalties or Ends of Our Lives are

## The Power of The Christian Witness.

- Never Centered in a Church Building or A Program.

① - The Witness begins and ends with the action of God.

- "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son." ...

- "I am not ashamed of the Gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation. ..."

- God has acted to deliver His people.

- To Break down the wall between God & Man.

- To Overcome Death with life.

② That He has Vastly Changed All Our Possibilities.

- I can become free and a Son of God.

- Moved from darkness to light, from death to life.

③ He can become The Dearest, Most Precious, Experience Of My Life.

- As a witness stands up and says what he has seen.

## His Witness Must Be Shared With Our Word.

### ① We Must Go To That Word.

- Caught in its power structures and vast organization,
- We share its shame and sin. Organized without God.
- We cannot escape and simply perform religious acts.
- We must go outside the camp and bear our cross,
  - We will share the other persons' burdens and his agonies.

### ② Our Strategy Is To See God's Word.

- (A) We Demonstrate this Gospel by an act.
- As Jesus washed his disciples' feet,
  - So we must give a cup of cold water.
- (B) We Speak Christ's Word.
- Sooner or later we must utter the witness.
  - We have underestimated the power of the word.
