Your Committee to which were referred the recommendations of the Professors, and also those of the Executive Board would recommend as follows:

1st That the Normal Department be dropped from the curriculum of the University.

2^d That there be no Business course advertised in the future.

3^d We recommend the creation of a Chair of History, Rhetoric and Elocution, and that Prof. Dietrich be elected to the chair.

4th We recommend that Miss Dicklow be assigned to the ~~chair~~ department of Modern Languages (including French and German), English Literature & Physiology.

5th We recommend that the chair of Latin shall also include, for the present,

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English Grammar and a class in Greek,
the Professor to be elected.

6th We appreciate the request made by
Prof. Charlton for \$160. to be expended in
the Scientific Department and would gladly
recommend its appropriation, if the condi-
tion of the Treasury was such as to warrant
it.

7th We recommend the appointment of
a Committee to select and recommend to the
Executive Board for appointment a Financial
