June 10 1876, Annual Report

The Trustees of Ottawa University met at Lawrence June 10 in connection with the State convention.

Present Emory in the chair, Prayer by Rev A Everol, Minutes of last meeting read v approved.

The order of business was to fill same vacancies.

When the falling vacancies were filled vig that of G A Blip, J R Darower v G Faster by the Election of E Gale Manhattan, D Sware of Leavenworth and G Manjeace Topeka.

The Report stated that the Centennial committee consenting of Challes, Hardwick, Williams, Anderson v Atkinson met in Atchison and decided on a design for the certificate and agreed to get 3000 published that the matter of curator was left with the Secty, and the publication of certificate v carful or was left with the Ex Committee.

That the Ex, Committee had gone forward v had 3000 certificate v 8000 circulars presented v were now ready for distribution.

After much deliberation it was moved and carried to instruct the Ex, Committee to put two agents in the State at once are a Salary of a percentage of which they would raise, one month v the the other South of the Kansas river.
