President Emory in the chair, Prayers by Rev A Overhol, Minutes of last meeting read & approved

The Order of Business was to fill some vacancies when the following vacancies were filled viz that of
 L. A. Bliss I R Downer & C. Foster by the election of E. Gal. Manhattan, J. Sloan & L. Annwood and C. Manjeau Topetka.

The Report of the Secretary was next read & received the Report stated that the Centennial Committee consisting of Chas. Hardwick, William Anderson & Atkinson met in Atchison and decided on a design for the certificate and agreed to get 5000 published that the matter of a circular was left with the Secy, and the publication of certificates & circulars was left with the Ex Committee.

That the Ex. Committee had gone forward & had 5000 certificates & 5000 circulars printed & were now ready for distribution.

After much deliberation it was moved and carried to instruct the Ex. Committee to put two Agents in the State at once on a salary of a percentage of what they would raise, one north & the other south of the Kansas River.

The Treasurer's Report was read by Wm Sumner was adopted & placed on file.

On motion the Ex. Committee was instructed and authorized to make such disposition of the operating assets as it could, to pay off the present indebtedness as far as possible.

The Trustees of Ottawa University met at Lawrence June 10 in connection with the State convention.

The Report stated that the Centennial committee consenting of Challes, Hardwick, Williams, Anderson v Atkinson met in Atchison and decided on a design for the certificate and agreed to get 3000 published that the matter of curator was left with the Secty, and the publication of certificate v careful or was left with the Ex Committee.
