

# Martin, Bemmels To Explain OU General Education

On February 2 and 9 President Martin and Dean W. D. Bemmels will present to the student body an over-all view of the college program. The February 9 assembly will be a group discussion with the student body in groups of approximately thirty students. Student leaders will moderate the discussions which will concern campus problems and questions about the general education program.

Although the assemblies are designed to present the general education program, President Martin and Dean Bemmels feel that they should also be opportunities for students to gain an understanding of what the college is trying to do with and for them.

The need for such assemblies was pointed out by Dr. Lewis Mayhew, Michigan State University, who was here this fall to speak at the Tri College Conference. After visiting the Student Council, he reported that he found many OU students were not familiar with the program.
