Authorized to nominate on half the Board of trustees of said University the University board electing the same + where^as this arrangement has been found to be any unsatisfactory to all parties instructed without any benefit to either party therefore resolved that we the board of the state convention assembled in the city of Topeka to Kas. in the spring of April 14th 1896 would respectfully recommend the following charges.

First. That the University board nominate + elect their own trustees as the members of this board are better able to judge the fitness of sum to fill said office than the ordinary nominating committee of the state convention.

Second. We would recommend that the University board Authorize the board of the State convention to appoint five name (all to be members of the overestimation in Kansas) who would passes the fitness in scholarship to be known as a board of visitors whose duties will be to visit Ottawa University at any time most comment to one be now-more of their member + visit the class rooms hear the recitations + c. + thus be able to judge the fitness of the teachers + the scholarship of the students + that said committee of visitors make a report to the trustees at its annual meeting making such recommendations as in their judgement will be for the best interest of the University.
