the associations and we request & authorized the  
Secy. to employ such their compensation not to exceed  
ten percent of what they raise & we request the Secy. to visit  
the associations to supply the canvassers & to aid them  
by importing such information & supplying them  
with Centennial certificates as may be desired.  
And in case he cannot visit all the associations we  
authorize him to employ some person or persons to go  
to such associations as he cannot attend who  
will act in his behalf in employing canvassers &c.
