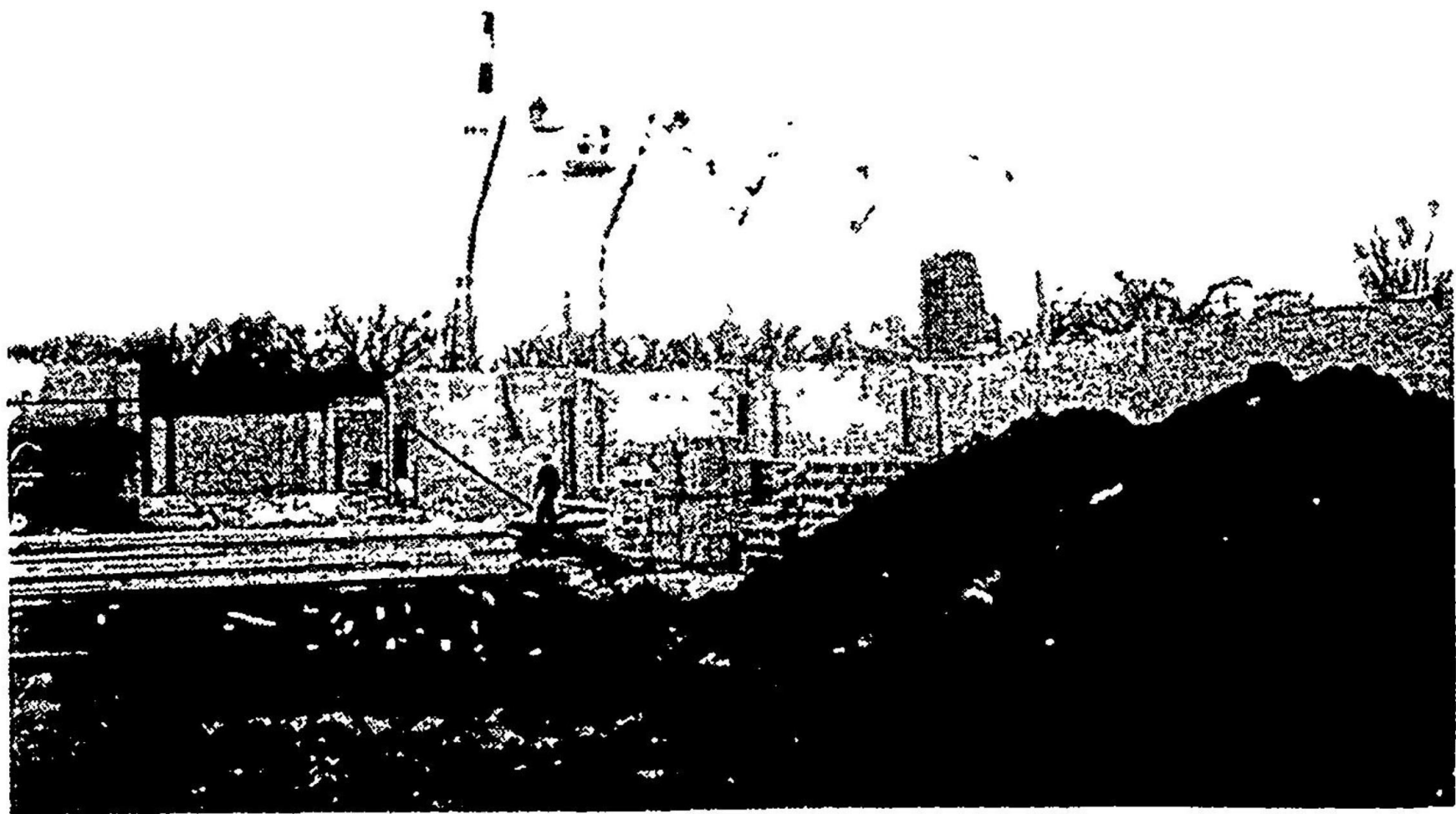




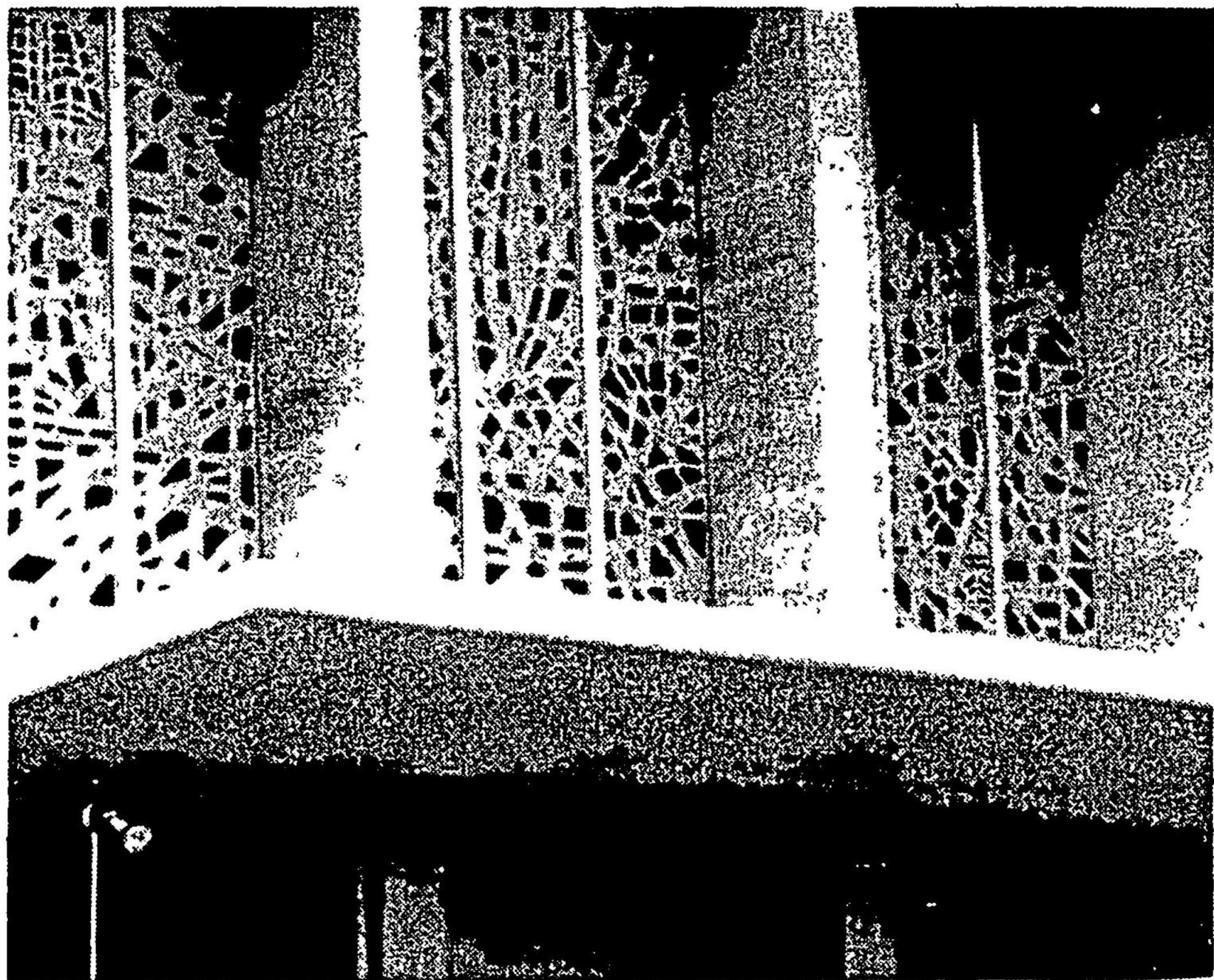

OU Chapel Dedicated

Monday, September 26, at 8 p.m. Ottawa university's new chapel was formally dedicated by Dr. Andrew B. Martin, President of O. U.

The chapel was made possible through a \$200,000 donation from an anonymous donor and over \$600,000 from the friends of the university.

Dr. Martin explained that the chapel was built to serve the religious program of the university and as an auditorium for other campus cultural events. As Dr. Martin put it, "Man cannot live on knowledge alone, he must have faith." He also stated, "the chapel would express our religious purpose."

Dr. Robert E. Davis, Executive Director of the American Baptist Board of Education and Publication, said he hoped the chapel wouldn't become a retreat from reality or a focus of religion on campus but rather that our religious purposes would exist all over the campus.

Dr. Nels F. S. Ferre gave his views on the place of the chapel in a Christian college. He hoped the chapel would be a moral building factor on campus. Said Dr. Ferre, "A chapel should be both church and college to see and speak the truth."
