

Jan 16 1875 The Ex. Committee of the Trustees
met at the Office of R. Atkinson

The Subject of Undertaking to save the
walls of the University building was under
discussion

It was ascertained that native lumber
could be obtained in exchange for land. The
following action was taken

Moved that R. Atkinson be a committee
to secure the lumber needed by exchanging
80 acres of land for the same & to superintend
the getting of the lumber on to ground owned

Moved that Mr. Crofoot be a committee
to employ Carpenter & Masons & Laborers & superintend
the work of the Roofing, joisting & putties covered.

Moved that Hotch & Sheldon be a committee
to solicit Sub. Comd

Moved that Dr. Tappan be a committee
to aid Mr. Crofoot in securing such men & help
as may be needed Comd.

Mr. J. H. Deford reported to the Ex. Com.
that he had been notified by Mr. Sears that the
Indian for a new treaty in the 100 Ld. Cox
would be called up on 22 inst. and asks
if the Board wished him to go to Topeka
& represent them. When it was voted to
request Mr. Deford to go & do so, was
ordered to pay him \$5 for traveling expenses

Jan 16 1875

The Ex. Committee of the Trustees met at the office of R Atkinson.

Moved that Holt v Sheldon be a committee to subject sub. Carried

Moved that Dr Tapping be a committee to aid Mr. Crafort in Securing such men v help as may be needed carried.

Mr J W Deford reported to Ex. Com that he had been note for by Mr Seam that the motion for a new trial in the 100 Lof cor would be called an 22 visit and arts of the Board would him to go to Topeka v represent them. When it was voter to request Mr Deford to go v the Tr. Was ordered to pay him \$15 for Traveling expences.
