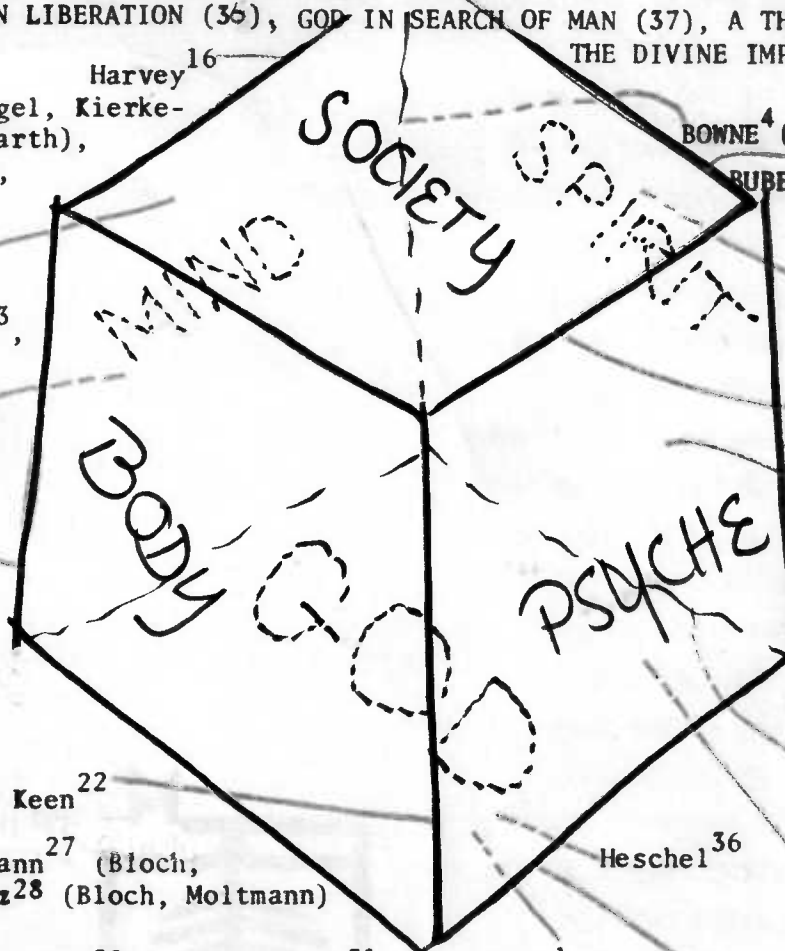

For each, a get-acquainted book is suggested. Parentheses indicate thinkers pos./neg.-influential on the person. FULL CAPITALS are the especially seminal thinkers, who have "seeded" the thought-plots of the rest of us Christians-as-thinkers.
