

As task, "integration" is putting it together. As pastoral task it's *PUTTING IT TOGETHER IN THE PARISH*, which is the title of the highly useful book by James Glasse (Abingdon/72). This thinksheet puts together the beatitudes which conclude, one each, the chapters. To help yourself integrate, write after each beatitude comments on "Here's where I am in integration in relation to this beatitude." Then use side two for "Here's where I'm determined to be." [Which is hardest for you?]

1. "Blessed is the pastor who has seen through the [conform/complaint] syndrome; he is free to move toward a more effective ministry."

2. "Blessed is the pastor who sets his own objectives; he knows what he is doing."

3. "Blessed is the pastor who plans his career; he knows where he is going."

4. "Blessed is the pastor who has paid his rent; he has time to give to other pursuits!"

5. "Blessed is the pastor who tames his time; he is free from the demons in the date-book."
