SUBJECT: Possible Equipment For KTJO

During the Board meeting, I talked at length with Dr. Marvin Wilson, who is the co-owner, with alumni Bob Bundy, of Radio Station KTPK in Topeka. It is a first class station and they are having a great time with it.

Their General Manager is Mr. H. "Pat" Powers. He is most willing to cooperate in a number of ways

1. By establishing internships for students interested in broadcast journalism,
2. By making equipment available to us that we could use, but that may be obsolete for their purposes. They now have an antenna and will likely have a 100 watt transmitter that could be given to the University for a gift-in-kind receipt to the corporation.

I talked with Mr. Bob Bundy this morning (11-7-83) and he assured me of their interest and that they would like to talk with us about the possibilities.

I would be happy to sponsor a trip to Topeka if there is interest. We would need to set up a meeting with Mr. Powers. It would also be nice if someone would call Dr. Wilson indicating our interest and our desire to follow-through to explore ways that we might be of mutual assistance. I will check with you individually.
