

MRS. RACHEL HILL OBITUARY.

Rachel L. Weide was born in Germany, February 21, 1873 and died in Kansas City May 18, 1908, from a complication resulting in blood poison. She was converted to the Christian faith 16 years ago in the German Evangelical church to which she was faithful to the end. She was married to L. L. Hill, December 28, 1897, to her was born five children, two of whom died in infancy, while the husband and three children; Walter G., aged 7 years, Hattie R., aged 3 years and Robert L., aged 15 months, her father and mother, six brothers and two sisters, and many relatives and friends remain to mourn her loss. while one sister has gone before. She was laid to rest May 20, at the Turkey Creek cemetery near her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Gottfried Weide who came to this county from Germany when she was a child and resided on a farm near Big Creek ever since. Her husband L. L. Hill was a school teacher here for eight years. They moved to Kansas City Missouri 5½ years ago where he attended dental college for two years, since which he has been connected with the Kansas City Star.
