## INSTRUCTIONS TO DEBATE CHAIRMEN

- 1. Secure your room number assignment from the chairmen headquarters at the Rec Hall, ground floor, Ad. Bldg. Please report directly to your assigned room.
- 2. Check to see if the judge and proper teams are present. If the judge or either team fails to show up in 10 minutes after time for the debate to start please report immediately to the chairmen head-quarters. (NOTE: Only one judge in debate.)
- 3. Your most important duty is that of timekeeper. If you failed to bring a watch borrow one from the judge or from one of the debaters.
- 4. Ask both members of each team what time warnings they desire. Raise your hand to indicate the time warning. At the end of the time limit for each speech stand and remain standing until the speaker resumes his seat.
- 5. Assist the judge in checking his ballot to see that the proper teams are present and help the judge in any manner that he may desire.
- 6. The order of speaking and time limits are as follows:

NOTE: The first affirmative constructive speaker may present the second affirmative rebuttal if he desires.

- 7. Return to contest headquarters for each new assignment. The chairman does not remain in the same room for succeeding rounds.
- 8. The proposition for debate is: Resolved, that labor should be given a direct share in the management of industry.
- 9. Keep the debate moving on time. Do not under any circumstances start a debate more than thirty minutes late. Fo do so would disrupt the entire schedule.
- 10. Chairmen do not return the judges ballot to the judges headquarters. Request the judge to return his own ballot.
