Job Placement and Continuing Education: Graduate

An alumni survey was conducted of all graduates University-Wide in the (07/01/2022 - 6/30/2023) academic year, 1-year (2021-2022), 3-years (2019-2020), and 5-years (2017-2018) after graduation.

University Wide

A total of 126 of 945 graduates University-Wide responded to the survey.

- 45 responded that they have or are pursuing additional education.
- Of those 37 respondents, 2 (5.41%) went on to pursue post-graduate education programs at Ottawa University.
- The remaining -respondents pursued advanced degrees in Clinical Trauma, Sex Addiction and Partner Trauma Therapy, Contract Management, ACE, Leadership in Innovation and Continuous Improvement, Forensic Psychology, Clinical Sexology, and NARM



How long after graduation did you find a job that required an advanced degree?






