

## COLLEGE RETENTION RATE

This retention rate for students at the residential College location measures the percentage of full-time, first-time degree/certificate seeking students who return to the institution to continue their studies the following Fall.

In the Fall of 2015, 172 students were reported as full-time, first-time degree/certificate seeking students. Of those students, 89 returned in the Fall of 2016, for a retention rate of 52%.

## APGS RETENTION RATE

The retention rate for students at the APGS locations (Arizona, Indiana, Kansas, Online, and Wisconsin) measures the percentage of new degree seeking students who return to the institution to continue their studies in the Fall +/- one term.

In the Fall of 2015, 231 students were reported as new to APGS as degree seeking students. Of those students, 122 returned +/- one term of the Fall of 2016, for a retention rate of 53%.
