

VOTER REGISTRATION AND INFORMATION

Ottawa University provides the official state internet address for voter registration to its students. Each student receives the internet address appropriate for the state of the campus they attend. OU provides this service for all federal elections and state elections for governor or other state chief executives. Notification of the internet addresses is sent to students 120 days prior to the deadline for registering to vote within each state. Students not residing in any of the following states should use one of the general links below to access their state information.
